It is hard to facilitate opportunities where people can encounter the love and power of God for themselves. The Alpha Day Together, formerly known as the Alpha Day Away, makes it easy for you to create these moments.

And as you do, your guests will be drawn to open their hearts to God in a new way and you will be amazed at what He does in their lives.

The goal of the Alpha Day Together is to intentionally and thoughtfully make space for guests to experience the love and power of God in a personal way. This happens through prayer

The following are a few scheduling options to make your Alpha Day Together both memorable and meaningful.

Option One: 2 Sessions with 3 Episodes

9:30 am

Leader huddle and prayer

10:00 am

Session One includes:

10 min – Welcome, Icebreakers, Games

5-10 min – Worship (optional)

25 min Watch: Who is the Holy Spirit?

15-Minute break

25 min Watch: What does the Holy Spirit Do?

25+ min Prayer Ministry (see below for details.)

12 pm Break

Offer a few recommended activities for the free time in the afternoon.

Offer Prayer slots during the afternoon

7:30 pm

Session Two includes:

5 min – Worship (optional)

30 min – Watch: How Can I be Filled with the Holy Spirit?

25+ min – Prayer Ministry

10 min – Debrief and end on a light note

9 pm End

Additional Scheduling Options

Option Two: 1 Session with 2 Episodes

Use the schedule for Session One at the time that works best for your group using the episodes “Who is the Holy Spirit?” and “How Can I Be Filled with the Holy Spirit?” This could be done in the morning or a single evening.

Option Three: 1 Session with 3 Episodes

Option 4 - 3 Sessions with 1 Episode on consecutive days.

Watch Who is the Holy Spirit?, What does the Holy Spirit Do?, and How Can I Be Filled with the Holy Spirit? on 3 consecutive days. Run things like a typical Alpha session, but connect on back to back days. The goal is to create an extra sense of togetherness through these sessions in particular.



Facilitating the Prayer Ministry



Our prayer for you is that God touches hearts and impacts lives in brilliant ways in these moments. You're going to do great.

Remember, the significant life change happens when we allow God to do what only he can do. It's not all up to you. He is with you.

Throughout these sessions, it's important to host intentional times of prayer ministry.

1. First, offer an invitation to begin or restore a relationship with Jesus and lead in a simple prayer.
2. Next, invite everyone who is willing to ask God to fill their hearts with His Holy Spirit and spend a few moments waiting on Him. This could be done in silence or done with some soft music or a worship song. You may want to let everyone know it is okay to turn their video off for this.
3. Then, ask the small group hosts and helpers to share any scriptures, words of knowledge, or pictures that came to their hearts. Then pray for those things that were shared. This can be a profound experience for both the guests and the hosts and helpers. If you are using breakout rooms, this part could be done in small groups.
4. After some time, ask guests if they would like to share anything that they may be experiencing or that they think would be a blessing to others in the group. Try to keep a prayerful atmosphere during this sharing.
5. Finally, let guests know that the hosts and helpers will be reaching out to offer more personal pray times later that day. These prayer times could include 2 hosts or helpers and one or two guests depending on what would make them feel most comfortable. Spend time listening, praying, and encouraging them! 10-15 minute slots are ideal.
